Students Feedback Report

Students feedback for session 2021-23 was taken on the various aspects of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed program and about the overall working of the institution. Various aspects taken for feedback are infrastructure of the college, teaching learning process, curriculum and support services.

Regarding infrastructure, 84% students strongly agree that institution provides good infrastructural facilities to them. They had the opinion that institution has sufficient classrooms with good furniture, labs, washrooms, common rooms, library, computer with Internet facilities, safe drinking water, ramp for physically challenged students, canteen, green lawn, auditorium and parking facility. All these infrastructural facilities are available and utilised to the optimum level

Regarding teaching learning process, about 46% students strongly agree and other 50% agree that teaching learning process in the institution is learner centred, self learning oriented, activity based, linked with values, interactive life skill based, versatile and linked with the community. It is carried out through use of ICT based methodology, seminars, workshops etc, which leads to the development of their higher order thinking skills.

In the area of curriculum, about 43% students strongly agree and other 52% agree that curriculum of B.Ed and D.El.Ed. program fulfil its aims and objectives. The curriculum is learner based, integrated, blend of theory with practice, caters the needs of society by engaging community in it. It inculcates various moral values among them. It includes various curricular, co-curricular and extra curricular activities; assignments, projects, case studies, visits, celebration of days, It prepares the trainees for real classroom problems.

In the aspect of support services, 32% students strongly agree and other 58% agree that college has good support services as free online registration, free coaching for entrance test and state level teacher eligibility test, different scholarship schemes, fee concessions for needy and meritorious students, book bank facility, ICT enabled technology etc are provided to them. Suggestions are also taken from the parents in Parents Teacher Meeting. Extension services cell organizers various extension lectures for developing their employability skill.

However some suggestions regarding enhancing the quality of washrooms and common rooms are also obtained, which have been forwarded to IQAC.
